

## The Quigley Open Sight Challenge

This competition is based around the shot Tom Selleck's character, Mathew Quigley took in the 1990s film *Quigley Down Under*. He shot a bucket at around 600 yards with an open sighted rifle with his first shot and then proceeded to repeat the feat twice more. A Black powder firearm competition in the same vane has attained almost cult status in the firearms world and while we can't promise buckets at 600 yards in the Walled Garden, we do have an airgun equivalent of this competition. Open sighted spring guns only, standing at long range at a target simulating the Quigley bucket. As a concession, spotting scopes are allowed. If you don't have a suitable rifle, don't despair as the club HW99's will be available. Each competitor will have 10 shots. In the event of a tie, sudden death rules apply.

The prize will be a DVD of the film, *Quigley Down Under*.
