Book in to diary noting time of arrival and prepare diary for booking in members.

Time	Various - Daylight hours
Duration	45 minutes
Sequence	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Locate target and spray main Body. 2. Spray “paddles” with contrasting colour. 3. Lightly oil pivot point and ensure paddles are free to move. 4. Repeat for all 20 targets. 5. Sanitise Hands.

Task	Booking in members - Commencing shooting
Time	Various - Daylight hours
Duration	15 minutes
Sequence	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open main gate. 2. Meet members at main gate and direct them to park in inner carpark. Ensure only members that have booked via the forum booking system are in attendance. 3. Remind all members to maintain 2m distancing. Ask all shooters to prepare kit at their cars. 4. When all members for that session have arrived re-lock gate. 5. Book all members into diary noting time of arrival. 6. When all are ready carry out briefing how course is laid out. 7. Proceed onto firing line maintaining 2m distancing. All members to sanitise hands. Members may either shoot solo or with a partner maintaining 2m distancing. All shooters to move around course in an anti-clockwise direction 8. Confirm all are ready to begin and blow to blasts on whistle.

Time	Various - Daylight hours
Duration	15 minutes
Sequence	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. When all members are finished shooting blow single blast on whistle to end session. 2. All shooters to sanitise hands. 3. When all have finished with sanitiser return dispenser to shed ensure stored in up-right position. 4. Enter time of departure for all members. 5. Secure Shed. 6. All to return to carpark maintaining 2m distancing and pack personnel equipment into cars. 7. Range Officer to open main gate. 8. Sanitise hands 9. When all members have left site secure lower gate. 10. Sanitise hands. 11. Exit main gate and secure. 12. Sanitise hands.
